

Privacy Policy

This privacy statement discloses the privacy practices for the Houston Center for Independent Living, Inc. website www.coalitionforbarrierfreeliving.com (“CBFL”), (“HCIL”), and affiliates Brazoria County Center for Independent Living (“BCCIL”), and Fort Bend Center for Independent Living (“FBCIL”).

CBFL is sincerely committed to your privacy. This statement explains what personally identifiable information we collect, how it's used and shared, what choices you have in disclosing your information, security, and how you can correct inaccuracies.

Information Collection and Use

CBFL / HCIL and its affiliates BCCIL and FBCIL is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. CBFL collects information from our users at several different points on our website.

Personal Contact Information Submission

In using this website, a user may input information into the screen asking “Do you want to know more?” During this process a user is required to give their contact information (such as name, address, and telephone numbers). This information is used to contact users and verify the authenticity of the information they have submitted. It is optional for users to provide additional personal information.

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. We do not use cookies to store your login information on your computer. We do not use cookies to track your browsing history or match it with your identity for any purpose such as market research or advertising.

Log Files

The web server does use IP addresses - all web servers need to track IP address to keep logs for legal reasons and the ability to track possible hack/hacker attempts. We do not use IP addresses to analyze trends, administer the site or gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.

Sharing

We do not share any information collected with funders or other organizations.

Security

This website takes every precaution to protect our users' information. This web site does not collect sensitive information such as credit card numbers or social security numbers.

Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, our CWIC's or WIPA's) are granted access to personally identifiable information.
